SUBSTITUTE INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF SALARY RATE

Substitutes for instructional staff, namely certified teachers, and paraprofessionals will receive remuneration for services rendered as follows:

- Certified Substitutes: \$11.50 hourly rate
 Certified substitutes must present a valid teaching certificate from any state in the
 United States to the Department of Human Resources to receive the certified pay.
 Retroactive pay will not be given for late submissions.
- Bachelor or Advanced Degreed Substitutes: \$10.50 hourly rate
 Degreed substitutes must present transcripts with proof of a Bachelor's Degree or
 higher to receive the degreed pay rate. Retroactive pay will not be given for late
 submissions.
- 3. <u>Associate Degreed Substitutes</u>: \$9.50 hourly rate
 Associate Degreed substitutes must present transcripts with proof of an Associate's
 Degree or sixty plus (60+) college credits to receive Associate degreed pay rate.
 Retroactive pay will not be given for late submissions.
- 4. Non-Degreed Substitutes: \$8.50 hourly pay Non-degreed substitutes must have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- 5. Paraprofessional, Secretary, or Duty Aide Substitutes: \$8.50 hourly rate
- 6. Long-Term Substitutes:
 - a. Certified Substitutes: \$18.65 hourly rate
 - b. Bachelor or Advanced Degreed Substitutes: \$17.65 hourly rate
 - c. Associated Degreed Substitutes: \$16.65 hourly rate
 - d. Non-Degreed Substitutes: \$15.70 hourly pay
 - e. Long term substitute pay does not apply to paraprofessional substitutes.
- 7. All substitutes shall only accept open positions though the automated substitute reporting system.

DEFINITIONS

Long Term Substitutes: a substitute working beyond ten (10) consecutive working days for the same certified teacher assignment will receive long-term hourly rates commencing with the eleventh (11th) day.

Paraprofessional Substitutes: individuals under the direct supervision of a properly certificated teacher for the areas they are providing support, i.e., special education, Title One, and Primetime classrooms.

Substitutes for Instructional Staff: any individual who temporarily replaces a certificated classroom educator and is paid a substitute teacher wage for one (1) day or more during a school year.
