Guidelines

 - c. include students, staff, and activities.
- 2. The theme, including layouts, headlines, captions and body copy, all arts and pictures, should represent the highest of photographic, artistic and literary quality.
- 3. The production of a school yearbook should be regarded as an honored opportunity, and should result in a cherished remembrance of school days within the District's secondary schools.
