## EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY AND NON-DISCRIMINATION

The Bonneville Joint School District No. 93 shall provide equal employment opportunities to all persons, regardless of their race, color, religion, creed, national origin, sex, age, ancestry, marital status, military status, citizenship status, pregnancy, use of lawful products while not at work, physical or mental handicap or disability, and other legally protected categories if otherwise able to perform the essential functions of the job with reasonable accommodations.

## Guidelines

- 1. The District will make reasonable accommodation for an individual with a disability known to the District, if the individual is otherwise qualified for the position, unless the accommodation would impose an undue hardship upon the District.
- 2. Inquiries regarding discrimination should be directed to the Title IX Coordinator.
- 3. Specific written complaints should follow the Uniform Grievance policy #4112 and procedure #4112P
